



## AMERICAN OSTEOPATHIC BOARD OF SURGERY

The American Osteopathic Board of Surgery (AOBS) is currently seeking a member to join the General Surgery and Surgical Critical Care Division of Examiners. The responsibilities of the Division of Examiners include:

- A. Maintaining an adequate pool of valid examination questions
- B. Construct qualification (written) examinations
- C. Construct certifying (oral) examinations
- D. Maintain adequate membership to assure a sufficient pool of questions
- E. Conduct and participate in test construction and examination review meetings at least twice a year. These meetings occur to ensure an adequate pool of test questions as well as to assure that examinations are prepared and ready to be administered at the scheduled examination times.
- F. Conduct additional test construction and examination review meetings as needed and approved by the Board of Directors
- G. Complete all board of directors and board of examiner approved “homework” assignments in a timely manner
- H. Perform final review and approval of the qualifying (written) and certifying (oral) examinations
- I. Perform final review and approval of all Longitudinal Assessment articles and examinations
- J. Serve as an Examiner for certifying (oral) examinations virtually (in person as approved by the AOA).
- K. Serve as an Examiner for clinical (Part 3) examinations (for Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery only)
- L. Actively recruit and mentor qualified, certified surgeons to serve as examiners for certifying (oral) and clinical examinations
- M. Approve Examiners and conduct reviews of their performance
